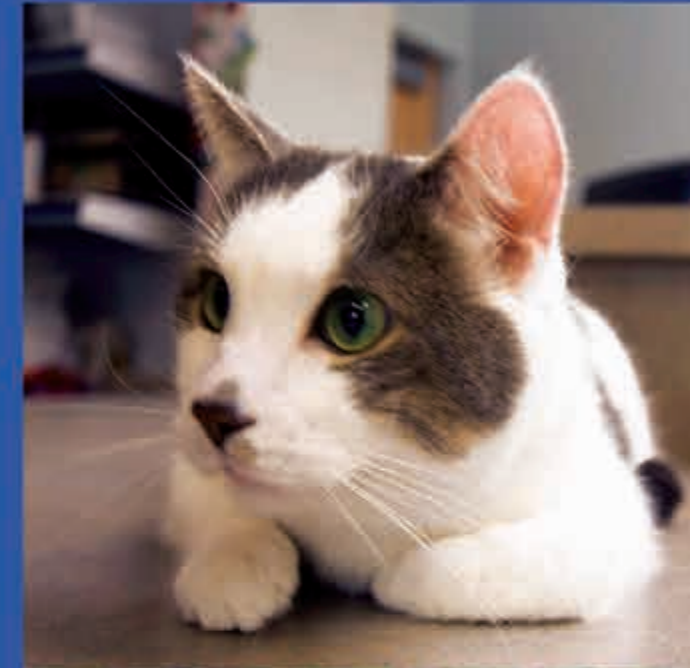

Boarding With Us

Having the ability to leave your pet with someone you trust not only gives you peace of mind, but also makes the entire experience less stressful on our furry family members. Our caring, attentive staff does their best to make your pet's stay as pleasant as possible. We provide a safe, comfortable retreat in a bright, spacious, climate controlled environment. Our guests receive fresh food and water to your specifications (and even treats if you wish) and exercise or playtimes are available for those visitors with a desire to stay active and in shape! When it is time to rest, your pet will find his/her comfy blanket or Kuranda Bed (available at some locations) a welcomed retreat second only to home.

Should your pet require medications or special care, our well-trained staff is here to provide for all of their needs, from giving oral medications to providing diabetics with insulin injections and monitoring blood sugars if necessary. If your pet should become ill during their stay, there is a doctor on-call and available during regular business hours, on Sundays and covering all holidays. We also have access to a 24-hour Emergency Hospital and board-certified Veterinary Specialists to care for your pet in an emergency (i.e., GDV/bloat, diabetic crisis, urinary blockage), available with prior signed approval.

It is our goal for you to enjoy your vacation or take care of business without having to worry about your pets. We know that you will miss them, and that they will miss you; our mission is to make that time away as pleasant, enjoyable and stress-free as possible, and make it so that the only other place your pet would rather be is home with you.

Vaccination Requirements

We require that all pets are current on their vaccinations. If vaccines were administered at another hospital, documentation verifying up-to-date status is required upon check-in.

About Fleas

To ensure a "flea free" environment for all of our boarders, we check each pet for fleas upon admission. If fleas are found, we will give your pet a dose of flea medication, and add this charge to your boarding bill.



Helpful Hints

Stress

Most pets adapt to the boarding environment and while they miss their families, their time with us is filled with the wonderment of different sights, smells and activities in our facility. A few boarders do not eat well, or may experience diarrhea, in a boarding environment and may lose weight, so bring along your pet's favorite snacks or food.

Belongings

Our facility is well-equipped to accommodate your pet's needs. Please be aware that we cannot be responsible for personal items (leashes, toys, blankets, etc.) that you may choose to leave with your pet during his/her stay. Such items can be lost or damaged and we kindly request that you leave valuable belongings at home.



Contact & Release Information

You will need to provide us with a phone number to reach you (or a phone number and the name of an individual authorized by you) in the event that your pet becomes ill while with us. We will make every effort to contact you or your designee to make you aware of any major problems. If we are unable to make contact, we will do everything deemed medically necessary to treat your pet.

If someone other than the owner will be picking up a pet after boarding, you will need to provide that information to our staff at check-in. We will not release a pet to anyone other than the owner without prior authorization.
